**There will be an overview of many inclusive and diverse LGfL resources available to support pupils with SEND including:**

- **Look Think Do**, a resource which includes school based photo based stories and skills materials to support pupils with social communication needs access everyday situations
- SEN Assist's **Early Shakespeare and Fairytales**, award winning resources designed specifically to support those with SEND
- **Audio Network**, a database of music tracks that support multisensory learning
- **J2E** content creation tools which include inclusive features to support those with SEND produce work that reflects their ability.
- The BETT award-winning **Busy Things** which includes many SEND friendly interactive and multisensory activities that are short, clear, motivating and which provide instant rewards
- Other materials including **The Talking Stories**, Ebooks and Early Vision resources
- Upcoming SEND specific materials e.g. **Employability** materials from AXIS Education, occupational therapy resources and possible materials from **Widgit Education**

Please note there will be plenty of opportunity for staff to try and discuss the resources with other SEND specialist during the 1.30pm session and some opportunity for hands on during the 4.00pm session.
