TUTORING OPPORTUNITIES

Staff with specialist expertise who have completed one of the tutored courses, can become tutors themselves, and this can become the most economical way of delivering training to whole schools or to staff from different schools. The most likely groups to become tutors are those working in support services, such as advisory and other specialist teacher roles, educational psychologists, speech and language therapists, and SENCOs.

On completion of a tutored course, prospective tutors need to complete a half day training course to prepare them for the role.
