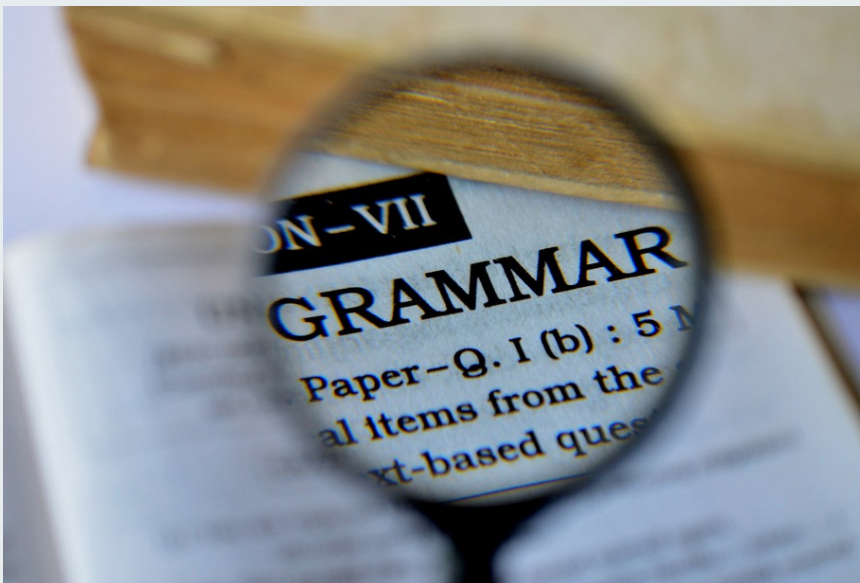


GRAMMAR TIME! INTEGRATING GRAMMAR INTO THE KS3 CURRICULUM

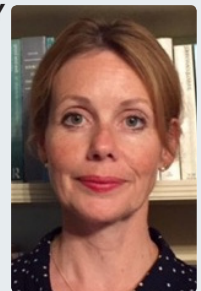
