

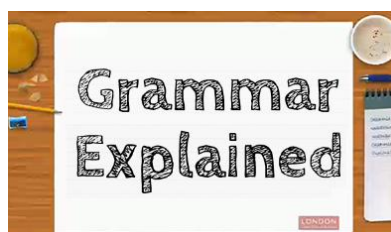


## FIVE WAYS TO SUPPORT TAs/LSAs
