Listening Books access for SEN students in a mainstream LGfL school



How to register a designated SEN student in a mainstream school to access Listening Books' resource via the LGfL USO.

Each person requiring the Listening Books resource will need to have an additional permission configured for their USO account. This can **ONLY** be done by **Nominated Contacts** via the LGfL USO support site.

You MUST only sign up those students who fall under Listening Books' eligibility criteria which is "someone who finds it difficult or impossible to read due to a physical impairment, specific learning difficulty or visual impairment".

Listening Books' copyright permissions do not cover all SENs. For example, they do not cover EAL, gifted and talented or behavioural problems. Please call Listening Books directly on 020 7407 9417 if you are in any way unsure.

If you are happy that the student meets these requirements, please follow the steps below:

Step 1 – The school's Nominated Contact needs to access the LGfL support site via www.support.lgfl.net.

Click on the icon to log in.

Step 2 – Go to the User Accounts tab and select User list / search




Step 3 – Search for the person you want to enable by entering either their USO username or their first and/or last name. click **Search/Refresh**.



Step 4 – When the person is listed in the search results, click on the **Details** link to the left of their name.



Step 5 – In the blue half of the page, scroll down on the list called Available categories until you get to "Listening



Books", **Click** on it to select it. Then click **Add selected** below the box to assign it to the individual. The profile change takes effect immediately after being added. There is no need for any further saving of changes.

The selected person's USO account will now be able to access Listening Books' resources.

Licence information

Listening Books has negotiated the audiobook licence for:

- 1. All teacher USO accounts
- 2. All designated SEN students in LGfL schools (see above for exceptions)

The licence is NOT for non SEN students' use in LGfL schools.

By completing this enabling action on your student USO accounts you are agreeing to the terms of this licence.

Any school found authorising non SEN students via this method may be excluded from using these resources.
